

What is it?

A compact freestanding text-to-speech scanner that needs to stand on a flat surface but can be easily moved from one room to another. The capture and reading process is started with a single button press, making it a relatively easy-to-use system. Includes function to skip forward or back through the text as it is being read back.

Why/when you might consider it?

- For a person who finds magnification tiring or unhelpful.
- It is a relatively simple piece of technology as person only needs to press one button to operate i.e. one button press captures and processes the text and reads it aloud.
- Specifically designed for people with sight loss e.g. intuitive and differently tactile buttons
- Can read a variety of text such as letters, text on food packaging, books and can cope with text being on a rounded surface e.g. a tin of food
- Advanced features available such as saving files and / or linking to a touchscreen – these require extra hardware, which would be purchased together with the Read Easy Move 2.

What do you need to be able to use it?

- A relatively small amount of space on a flat surface
- A nearby plug socket
